MINUTES OF BID OPENING

The meeting began at 2:00 p.m. on April 2, 1986 and was held in the City Council Room at City Hall. Bids were opened on two contracts. Contract Number Two deals with the extension of water lines and does not use CDBG funding. Contract Number One is for the construction of the wastewater treatment plant and involves a \$500,000 Community Development Block Grant from that State.

Contract Number Two bids were opened first. The bidders and their bids are as follows:
