Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

July 1, 1986

The Town of Englewood Board of Commissioners met in regular session on July 1, 1986 at 7:30 p.m. Present were Commissioners Middleton, Nichols, Reid, and Armstrong. After a call to order, the Mayor called for a review of the minutes of the previous meeting. A motion to accept the minutes as presented was made by Armstrong and seconded by Nichols. All ayes.

Upon motion by Armstrong, and a second by Reid, the 1986-87 Budget was adopted on the third and final reading. All ayes.

Discussion was initiated next concerning the need for money for municipal operations until the tax collections begin in October. A motion was then made by Armstrong and seconded by Reid to request the State Comptroller to permit the borrowing of up to \$30,000.00 by the Town of Englewood to fund operations until tax monies begin coming in. All voted aye.

Upon unanimous approval the following resolution was then adopted:

After a discussion concerning the 1986-87 Tax Rate, a motion was made by Armstrong and seconded by Reid to leave the 86-87 Tax Rate at \$2.18 per each one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of taxable property. All voted aye. The Tax Rate for 1986-87 was then officially set at \$2.18.

After discussion concerning expenditures, Commissioner Nichols then raised the motion that no expenditures outside of normal operating costs could exceed \$100.00 unless board approved. The motion was seconded by Middleton.

Upon request by Commissioner Reid to raise patrolman Baxter to the same level as a certified officer due to the fact that he had finished the Police Academy, a unanimous decision was made by the Board to go by the standards set previously before concerning the raising of salary.
