

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

May 5, 1987

The Englewood Board of Commissioners met in regular session on May 5, 1987 at 7:30 p.m. Commissioners present were Middleton, Armstrong, Conner, and Nichols.

The first order of business following the call to order was the review of the minutes of the previous meeting. After review, a motion was made by Armstrong to accept the minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Conner. All ayes.

Discussion next ensued on the widening of the street leading to the swimming pool. It was stated that 30 foot was needed for the safety of the children walking to the pool. A motion was then made to initiate proceedings in order to obtain 30 feet of the McBrayer property for the proposed widening of the street. The McBrayer property was made by Armstrong and duly seconded by Nichols. All ayes. in addition, it was agreed among the Board members that the stop sign at the pool should be changed to Franklin Street.

The sewer problem at the Cass residence was discussed.

There was an agreement among the Board members that the park could be used for the Outreach Program of the First Baptist Church.

Discussion on the cleaning of the building and the TML Insurance proposals was tabled until next meeting.

The Mayor then informed those present that letters had been sent to some property owners stating that their property should be cleaned up within 30 days or the City would clean it up and charge to the property owner as an addition to their taxes.

The Mayor then informed the Board that Homecoming 87 was to be observed in town on the last weekend of June.

It was then noted that streets to be paved soon were Sawmill Rd. from Erskin Long's to Manilla Road, McKinney Street, Jeralds St., and Springarden Avenue to Franklin Street.

Request was then made by Chief Jack for a raise for patrolman Tim Russell. This will be looked into at budget time.

With no further business, a motion to adjourn was made to Conner and seconded by Nichols. All ayes.
