

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

October 1, 1987

A called meeting of the Englewood Board of Commissioners was held on October 1, 1987 at 4:00 p.m. Present were Commissioners Conner, Nichols, Middleton, Recorder C.A. Goodin, Police Chief Hershell Jack, and citizen Carrine McConkey. In reference to the Police Dept. the Board discussed a crisis due to the resignation of Officer Russell. After much discussion on the pros and cons of hiring an older or younger person for this position, the Board decided to advertise the job and check with the Sheriff's Dept. for possible applicants. The Board also hired H.D. Studdard as a part-time patrolman.

Members discussed purchasing new Christmas lights for the City. Conner made motion to buy new lights and Nichols seconded. All ayes.

Discussion about heating and air conditioning. Mayor Middleton discussed that he was still checking on it and would have something to report at a later meeting.

The Board also discussed the pros and cons of an industrial rate on garbage. Then main topics of the discussion was the garbage at the Allied Hosiery and M&M Manufacturing plants. It was decided to note the weight of the garbage of these plants for the next few weeks before making a decision on this matter.
