

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

November 3, 1987

Englewood Board of Commissioners met in regular session, November 3, 1987 at 7:30 p.m. Present were Commissioners Conner, Nichols, Middleton, Armstrong, Police Chief Hershell Jack, and C.A. Goodin, Recorder.

Mayor Middleton called for a moment of silence in respect to deceased police commissioner Willard Reid. Mayor Middleton called for a review of last meeting minutes and were accepted with Armstrong first motion and Conner second. All ayes.

Third reading Cross-Connection Ordinance. Middleton asked to accept. Armstrong first. Conner second. All ayes.

Middleton wants letter to Fire Chief and Assistant not to mess with fire hydrants and not practice drills after hours and pumps at plant are off.

Martin came in with drain line problems on house --too low for sewer lines--needs to repair and wants city assistance in repairing. Discussion: decides must get signed authorization of easement from property owners Burnette and Kinser and then Board will decide later in called meeting what it will and will not do in assistance.

Chief Jack explained problems with Paige injury--medical and explained pursuit that took place.

Chief Jack asked about giving monies to drug task force. Says he has \$350 in drug fund and asks for another \$650. Making \$1,000 total contribution. Discussion: Board members agree is good effort.. Motion made to given additional \$650. Conner. Middleton seconds. All ayes.

Chief Jack mentioned in-service training for reserves that Jack Million will be conducting in front of jail.

Chief Jack says part-time policemen troubles means need extra man on force. Erskin Long says he will fill in if needed when someone out sick, vacation days and midnights if necessary.

Discussion: Agrees Erskin can fill in if needed--must notify office-- does not think another full-time policeman needed.

Committee reviewing police procedure manual (Conner, Nichols) will meet with Chief Jack and return to board with findings.

Mr. Goodin informs still weighing garbage.

No further business.

Motion by Conner to adjourn--seconded by Nichols.
