

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

February 2, 1988

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners met in regular session Tuesday, February 2, 1988, in the Library at City Hall. The meeting was held at 7:30 p.m.

Mayor Middleton called the meeting to order with Commissioners Conner, Moses, and Armstrong present.

After reviewing the previous minutes, motion was made by Conner, seconded by Armstrong that they be accepted. All ayes.

Mayor Middleton informed the Commissioners that a letter had been placed in each one's folder by Assistant Chief of Police, Glenn Cooley. The letter ask that the Board give Patrolman Bobby Queen a raise of \$1.00 due to the circumstances of the Police Department at the present time. The letter stated that Mr. Queen had been doing an exceptional job and had been willing to work extra hours due to the shortage of personnel on the Police staff. Motion was made by Middleton that Officer Queen's salary be raised from \$4.00 per hour to \$5.00 per hour. This was to be done as a one time thing and would not change the policy of hiring new officers for the Police Department. Motion was seconded by Armstrong. All ayes.

Middleton informed the Board that the Student Council of Englewood School is planning to place a sign in the downtown area that will be used to announce school programs to the public.

Middleton reminded the Board that the Public Service Commission would be holding a meeting for the subscribers of the Tellico Telephone Company concerning a rate increase. The meeting was being held in the Council Chamber at City Hall, Monday, February 8, at 6:30 p.m. Mr. Middleton stated that the public was urged to attend.

Motion was then made by Commissioner Armstrong, seconded by Conner that the meeting be adjourned. All ayes.
