

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on  
March 23, 1988

The Town of Englewood Board of Commissioners met in called session on March 23, 1988 at 8:00 p.m. for the purpose of consideration of Chancery Court taxes for Eureka Garment Co.

Commissioners present were Armstrong, Conner, Moses, and Middleton.

Representing the Reynolds', Commissioner Armstrong requested that the City accept a \$4,000 check from the Reynolds' at this time with the remainder of the \$9,000 taxes being paid in the fall. The only way the City would lose money would be if the company became insolvent before the final payment is made. If this is accepted, then the taxes due in Chancery Court would be dismissed. Discussion then ensued.

A motion was then made by Commissioner Armstrong to grant the above request based on approval by the City lawyer. With no Second forthcoming, the motion dies.

A motion was then made to adjourn. All ayes.
