Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

May 31, 1988

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners met in called session, Tuesday, May 31, 1988 at 8:00 a.m. in Englewood Library.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Middleton with Commissioners Conner, Moses, and Armstrong present.

They Mayor then informed the Commissioners that the Student Council of Englewood School had only \$650.00 toward the erection of the lighted sign at the gazebo.
