

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

June 27, 1988

The Englewood Board of Commissioners met in called session on June 27, 1988 at 8:30 a.m. for consideration of the 1988-89 tax rate and budget. After a review of the proposed 1988-89 Fiscal Budget, a motion was made to set the 1988-89 tax rate at \$2.18 per each one hundred dollars of assessed property value. The motion was seconded by Nichols. All ayes.

A motion was made by Conner and seconded by Moses to adopt the 1988-89 Fiscal budget on the first reading. All ayes.

Included in the budget was a three week vacation for all employees after 10 years of service. Fire dispatch personnel will be on a \$260.00 salary with no extra pay for holidays. Board discussed relief employees that would work fire dispatcher position for vacation, sick or other relief hours that needed to be filled. Relief employees must be other than regular fire dispatchers. Motion made by Moses and seconded by Nichols to accept above rules concerning fire dispatch work. All ayes.

All employees except fire dispatch, will receive a 5% cost of living raise. Motion was then made and duly seconded to adjourn the meeting. All ayes.
