

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

September 6, 1988

The Town of Englewood Board of Commissioners met in regular session on September 6, 1988 at 7:30 p.m. Commissioners present included Middleton, Nichols, and Conner.

A review of the minutes of the previous meeting was called for by the Mayor. A motion was then made by Conner and seconded by Nichols to accept the minutes as presented. All ayes.

Notes by the Mayor:

Wanda Lewis had requested a check on her variance by the State Planner when a change was made from ownership to rental. It was reported that the variance did not change.

Reported that the jogging track and walkway over 411 was still being discussed-reviewing catalogs.

Concerning the Englewood Action Group, the Mayor reported that the State Planner could go to Sugar Creek, Ohio to tour the town. The Action Group also requested that the extra cost of the sign at the gazebo be born by the City. A motion was made by Nichols and seconded by Conner to erect the brick sign with a flower box at a cost of \$860.00. All ayes.

Chief Jack then informed the Board that he had applicants for a patrolman position, one from Niota and Mike Garren from Englewood. It was suggested that Mike Garren be placed on the reserve and learn about the police department. No action was taken concerning the filling of the position.

Concerning Ordinance 070588, motion was made by Conner and seconded by Nichols to adopt the Ordinance on third and final reading. All ayes.

With no further business, the meeting was adjourned by motion of Nichols and a second by Conner. All ayes.
