

**Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on
March 6, 1990**

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Englewood met in regular session, Tuesday, March 6, 1990.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Conner with all members of the Commission present. Prayer was held by Minister Todd Cyphers.

Motion was made by Long, seconded by Armstrong to accept the minutes of the February meeting. All ayes.

Jane Flowers and Patsy Decker gave a report on the Seminar held in Pigeon Forge in reference to town improvement.

Carl Lester, manager of Tellico Telephone Company, presented a proposal to the Board asking that the Town of Englewood grant a franchise to the phone company. Motion was made by Armstrong, seconded by Cass to accept the proposal on first reading. All ayes.

Jeanette Richesin and Minnie Burger were present asking that the Board check into a problem concerning a ditch that is creating a water problem for residents on Sunset Avenue. The Board agreed to look into the matter.

Charlie Pickel informed the Board that he was asking the Planning Commission to grant a variance in order to set a trailer on his property for his mother, Anna Lou Pickle. The Board stated that if the Planning Commission granted the variance, a called meeting would be held for Board approval.

Police Chief Jack asked the Board to raise Patrolman Tim Smith's wages. Motion was made by Long, seconded by Cass, to raise Smith to \$6.75 per hour. All ayes.

Discussion was then held concerning adding court costs to police fines and fees. Attorney Cunningham stated that he would look into the matter and inform the Board of what he finds at the next monthly meeting.

The Board instructed the office to have pictures of the depot and old high school framed for display in Assembly Room.

Long informed the Board that he would check on bids for a new Utility Truck. Armstrong ask that the office draw up specifications for Commissioner Long.

The Board then discussed setting up work sessions concerning garbage pick-up and condemnation of dilapidate property.

Motion was made by Armstrong, seconded by Brown, to adjourn. All ayes.
