

## Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

October 1, 1996

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Englewood met in regular session, Tuesday, October 1, 1996 at 6:00 p.m. in the Assembly Room at City Hall.

The meeting was called to order with Commissioner Davis, Brock, Middleton, and Mayor Cass present. Commissioner Long was not present. Invocation was given by Commissioner Davis.

Motion was made by Brock, seconded by Davis to accept the September 1996 meeting minutes. All ayes.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to donate \$250.00 to the McMinn Clean Commission. All ayes.

Concerning the 1991 4-wheel drive Bronco, Commissioner Brock presented two options to the Board:

Option #1: The vehicle be used as a city vehicle-the city will pay the total cost of the vehicle.

Option #2: The City Fire Department and the Rural Fire Department half the cost of the vehicle and city employees be allowed to drive it only in emergency situations.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Davis to accept Option #2. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Davis to donate \$50.00 to the Lion's Club Horse Show. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Brock for the city to place a water tap at the Barbara Culberson residence. The tap is to be made where Ms.Culberson's wants it at no charge to her (due to the original tap being placed where contractor building her house requested it be placed). All ayes.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to allocate \$40,000.00 for paving of streets. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Davis to allow Kenny Dickson to mow the soccer fields and the field at the Sewer Plant for hay. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Middleton, to allow Bob King to use a trailer as his office located on his car lot. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Brock to start clean-up process on any residential property obtained through back taxes. All ayes.
