

**Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on
February 17, 1997**

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Englewood met in called session Monday, February 17, 1997 at 6:00 p.m. in the Assembly Room at City Hall.

Mayor Simpson called the meeting to order with Commissioners Davis, Raper, Brock, and Middleton present. Invocation was given by Commissioner Davis.

Mayor Simpson then stated that the first item on the agenda was the Water Contract with Etowah. He informed the Board that he had sent a letter dated January 15, 1997 asking for renegotiation. As of this date I have not been contacted by either the Etowah City Commission or the Utility Board. Hale Booth called to inform me that he would be in Athens and would contact me for a meeting on that date. He called and informed City Hall that he had to return to Chattanooga due to his meeting in Athens running longer than expected. He was to call back but so far there has been no contact. Mayor Simpson then made a motion that Englewood notify the City Commission of Etowah that if there is to be no discussion on the contract then the Town of Englewood will not honor it. Motion was seconded by Middleton. Davis-Nay, Raper-Aye, Brock-Aye, Middleton-Aye, Simpson-Aye.

The Mayor then informed the Board that the Mayor's statement on the bond issue was no longer on the agenda. He stated that if a bonding should ever occur that it would be done through Englewood. This is in reference to the Mine Road Landfill.

Motion was then made by Brock, seconded by Middleton to hire Dewayne Buckner as maintenance worker. All ayes.

Motion made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to adjourn the meeting. All ayes.
