Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

May 12, 1997

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Englewood met in regular session, May 12, 1997 at 6:00 p.m. in the Assembly Room at City Hall.

He stated that some of the property would be very costly and the Board was searching out several ways to handle this without the taxpayers having to bear the burden of having this property cleaned up.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Brock to hire Laurie Barber, Seth Moses, Misty Dolan, and Erin Moses as full time Englewood Municipal Pool Lifeguards and Christina Keith as substitute lifeguard. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Davis to accept monthly billing errors in the amount of \$570.53. All ayes.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to accept on second reading Garbage Pick-Up Ordinance. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Brock to accept on second reading Water and Sewer Leak Ordinance. All ayes.

The TML Risk Management Pool property valuation-estimated replacement cost was tabled until the next meeting.

Motion was made by Brock, seconded by Middleton to hire Richard Robinson as Reserve Police Officer. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Brock to adjourn the meeting. All ayes.
