

**Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on
September 8, 1997**

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Englewood met in regular session Monday, September 8, 1997, at 6:00 p.m. in the Assembly Room at City Hall.

Mayor Simpson called the meeting to order with Commissioners Davis, Raper, Brock, and Middleton present. Invocation was given by Commissioner Davis.

Mayor Simpson then informed those present that he had been notified that the Town of Englewood had been approved to receive a \$500,000.00 Community Development Block Grant to be used toward the Zion Hill Water Extension.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to accept the minutes from August 1997. All ayes.

Motion was made by Davis to accept monthly billing errors in the amount of \$102.27 for August 1997. All ayes.

Davis then gave an update on the Community Park. He informed the Board that he was in the process of trying to get the playground equipment donated by Hardees moved to the park. He then discussed installing power to the stage at the park in order to hold the CAGE Bluegrass Festival. He stated that the Town would be receiving a \$2000.00 grant from the County to be used toward park improvements.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to install power to the stage at the park. All ayes.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to pour a concrete pad to set the playground equipment on. All ayes.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to move the playground equipment to the park and accepting the lowest bid to move it. All ayes.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to donate \$100.00 to the Englewood Lion's Club. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Raper to donate \$100.00 to Central Soccer. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Brock to accept on first reading Ordinance #090897.9-Court Costs/Administrative Fees. All ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Brock to adjourn the meeting. All ayes.
