Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to accept on first reading Ordinance# 060898.14-an Ordinance to Amend Article X of the Englewood Zoning Ordinance to Establish Standards for Appearance for the Appearance of Manufactured Homes. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to raise the pool manager's salary to \$5.50 per hour. All Ayes.

Englewood Representative Sheila Holden was present to give the Board an update concerning the McMinn County Clean Commission.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Davis to donate \$250.00 to the Englewood Lions Club. All Ayes.

Edith Watson reported a problem concerning trash being thrown out on the street near her home, The Mayor stated that the city would do extra policing of the area and would check into placing a street light in the area.

Frances Johnson ask that the city trim the trees and bushes located at Kale Street and Old Englewood Road. The Board stated that this would be done.

Public Works Director Joe Cline then informed the Board of a request from Walter Rackley to change the name of Duggan Street to Rackley Street . The Board stated that they felt the name of the street should remain Duggan Street.
