

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

October 12, 1998

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Englewood met in regular session, Monday, October 12, 1998 at 6:00 P.M., in the Assembly Room at Englewood City Hall.

Motion was made by Brock, seconded by Middleton to accept the September minutes. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Brock, seconded by Middleton to accept on the second reading Ordinance #091498.16-Title VI. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Brock, seconded by Middleton to change the speed limit to 30 mph on all secondary streets unless otherwise posted. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Middleton, seconded by Brock to accept billing errors from the month of September 1998. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded Middleton to commit to donating a lot of property located on Niota Road which the Town of Englewood had acquired through delinquent property taxes. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Middleton to adjust Eddie Barnett's water bill. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Davis, seconded by Brock to donate up to \$1,000 to purchase Christmas Decorations for the Town. Lib Raper had been getting donations from some of the area Merchants to help with the decorations also.
