The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Englewood met in regular session, Monday, May 8, 2000 at 6:00 P.M., in the Assembly Room at Englewood City Hall.

Mayor Simpson informed everyone that Jerry Weiss had been awarded the bid for the Zion Hill-Cumberland Heights Water line Extension Project.. He also stated that May 18, 2000 was the deadline for qualifying to run the Englewood city election that will be held in August of this year.

Motion was made by Cass, seconded by Raper to accept the April 2000 Minutes. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Cass, seconded by Raper to table item #2 of the agenda. Central High School Alumni Association Donation: \$100.00 until the Board received more information concerning the request. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Cass, seconded by Raper to have city property obtained through delinquent taxes surveyed and appraised, with the exception of the property located behind City Hall. All Ayes. This will begin the process of selling this property.

Motion was made by Cass, seconded by Raper to accept on first reading Zoning Ordinances: #050800.25A, #050800.25.25C. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Cass, seconded by Raper to authorize Commissioner Davis to review pool applications and hire the Pool Manager and Life Guards and to set the opening date of the pool for Saturday, June 3rd with no admission charges that day. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Raper, seconded by Cass to accept monthly billing errors in the amount of \$281.66. All Ayes.

The Board then reviewed the following bids to paint the Municipal Building. Ted Watson, \$2900.00, Gary Brown \$2750.00 an calico Painting 3680.00. Motion was made by Raper, seconded by Cass to accept the bid from Gary Brown in the amount of \$2750.00. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Cass, seconded by Raper to pay the hourly rate for a County grader operator to work on preparing the soccer fields at the park. All Ayes.

The Board then reviewed estimates from the Rogers Group on street paving, The estimate was \$30,349.56. Motion was made by Cass, seconded by Raper to approve the estimate and amend the paving budget for \$46,000 to \$51,000. All Ayes.

Polly Bennett was present with a complaint concerning the condition for the Goodin property next to her residence. Beth Sizemore was present with a complaint that the Sewer Plant property was being used as a dump.
