

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

July 10, 2000

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Englewood met in regular session, Monday July 10, 2000 at 6:00 P.M., in the Assembly Room at Englewood City Hall.

Mayor Simpson called the meeting to order with Commissioners Ralph Davis and Robert Cass present, Commissioner Elizabeth Raper was not present.

Invocation was given by Commissioner Davis.

Motion was Cass, seconded by Davis to accept the Minutes from June 2000. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Cass, seconded by Davis to accept the monthly billing errors and adjustments in the amount of \$305.81. All Ayes.

The Board then reviewed bids for a new Garbage truck. Motion was then made by Davis, seconded by Cass to accept the bid for an International Chasis from Cherokee Truck for \$69,221.00. All Ayes.

The Mayor then informed those present that the Town had received payment from Bill and Steve Sloan for property sold to them located on Highway 411. He also stated that the Town had been notified that Amsouth Bank would be close its Englewood Branch in October 2000.
