

Minutes from the Commission Meeting held on

June 21, 2001

The Mayor and Board of Commissioners of the Town of Englewood met in called session, Thursday, June 21, 2001 at 10:00 A.M., in the Assembly Room at Englewood City Hall.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Moses with Commissioners Roach, Cass and McConkey present. Commissioner Simpson was not present.

The Board reviewed the budget for the fiscal year 2001-2002. Discussion was held concerning a water rate increase, Roach stated that there had been a 2% water rate increase since 1992 and that the city needed to keep up with the rate of inflation. Roach stated that no one likes to increase charges but that sometimes it has to be done. Roach stated that a 12% increase was needed, McConkey felt that a 8% increase was enough or 10% at the most. Motion was made by Roach, seconded by McConkey to increase the Water and Sewer rate 11%. All Ayes.

Motion was then made by McConkey, seconded by Roach to accept on 2nd Reading the budget for fiscal year 2001-2002. All Ayes.

Jane Young was present to discuss the charge for a water and sewer tap at 121 Conner Drive. Ms. Young stated that Mayor Moses had told her that there would be no charge for the taps. Moses stated that he did not have the authority to do this and apologized to Ms. Young for any misunderstanding. Motion was then made by McConkey, seconded by Roach to have Ms. Young pay \$2222.25 for the water and sewer tap within 30 days. All Ayes.

Motion was made by Roach, seconded by McConkey to table agenda item #3-Bradfield Environmental Service/group water investigation. Roach Aye, Cass Nay, McConkey Aye. Moses Aye.

Motion was made by McConkey, seconded by Moses to agree for the Town to pay one-third of the cost of Tristate Testing/core drilling for the Industrial Park. Roach Nay, Cass Nay, McConkey Aye, Moses Aye, Moses then used Section 15 of the Town of Englewood's Charter to break the tie vote by voting Aye.

Motion was made by McConkey, seconded by Cass to adjourn the meeting. All Ayes.
